“Playing & Pretending” (1972)

Spontaneous Drama with Children (Ellie Irwin) 23 min.

This film demonstrates many different forms of spontaneous drama with preschool and latency age children. A variety of play and drama activities are illustrated, including creative movement, puppetry, and role play, and the improvisation of a child's scary dream. (Carlow College)

“Children & the Arts: A Film about Growing” (1973) (Judy Rubin) 23 min.

This film includes activities in music, dance, art, poetry, and drama--with an emphasis on the mental health values common to all. It demonstrates ways in which the arts help children to develop as creative comfortable people.
